Dear Parents/Carers,

RE: West Stow Anglo-Saxon Village – Thursday 30th November 2017

This is to inform you of the final preparations for our trip to West Stow Anglo-Saxon Village.

As a lot of what we are exploring will be outdoors, please ensure your child comes to school appropriately dressed and all items must be labelled with names please. We have been lucky to have had named items returned in the past although the children are responsible for all of their belongings.

Your child needs to come to school in their uniform as normal and sensible outdoor school shoes as they usually wear to school. If the weather is wet then please bring wellington boots. They should be wearing a proper school coat, and recommend they bring a pair of gloves and hat to wear if it is really cold that day. Please no scarves. (All items labelled with your child's names please).

Children must arrive to school punctually as we aim to leave at 9am sharp. We have a structured and timetabled day and we want to ensure we are able to complete this schedule.

Your child also needs to bring a packed lunch with them – we recommend in a carrier bag (named), so all rubbish can be disposed of once finished. Two drinks of water (named) would be a good idea. Children won't need a snack on the visit; just their main lunch is all they need.
