To further enrich our learning about the Ancient Egyptians, we have arranged a visit from 'History Off The Page' for an **all day** event on **Tuesday 17<sup>th</sup> October 2017**.

On this day, your child will experience life as it would have been during the 14<sup>th</sup> Century BC, during Akhenaten's reign as Pharaoh.
