However this can present challenges to keeping ourselves safe online. Julie reminded the children about necessities such as

- Not sharing real names and e mail addresses when gaming online
- What to do when others are being offensive when gaming online
- Use trusted sites only
- Never post pictures of yourself and only use nicknames
- Importance of telling a trusted adult if anything occurs that makes you feel uncomfortable
