Dear Parents/Carers,

We have provisionally booked the year 6 residential visit with a company called PGL for the summer term 2019. The visit will be a 4 night residential course at the PGL Educational Activity Centre at Caythorpe Court in Lincolnshire, from Monday 24th June – Friday 28th June 2019.

PGL is a leading residential activity centre provider that offers a rewarding educational programme combined with exciting outdoor and indoor activities together with secure and controlled residential accommodation. Residential courses organised by the school are an optional, but invaluable part of the National Curriculum. Pupils benefit enormously from the experience, both educationally and socially, and we know that this visit will prove to be both enjoyable and very worthwhile. The cost of the visit will be approximately £410.00 which includes accommodation, food, all activities and transport. The exact cost is number dependent and will be confirmed in due course. We will require a **non-refundable** deposit of £50 to be paid by **MONDAY 30th APRIL** and a further letter will follow after the meeting with details of this.

When you have paid your deposit, and we have confirmed the trip and numbers with PGL we will be able to advise you of the exact cost. You will be able to pay in instalments of any amount, at any time, over the months leading up to the trip. However, we require the whole amount to have been paid by **Friday 29th March 2019**.

This residential visit is only available to pay on WisePay. Due to the amount of money involved the school are unable to accept cash or cheques. If you need a reminder of your log in details/password please ask in the office. By paying online it is easy for you to see your payments at any time and is available to use 7 days a week/24 hours a day.

There will be meetings for parents and children in Year 5 on **Thursday 15th March at 5pm** and another meeting at **7pm** so you can choose which meeting to attend, where you will be able to find out more about this visit and have the opportunity to ask any questions.

The school will not be offering any extra-curricular outings or visits for children who do not attend this residential visit. These children will be expected to attend school and will have lessons as normal.
